The PhD School in Physics of the Physics and Astronomy Department of the University of Bologna announces the opening of 16 PhD positions in all areas of Physics.

The duration of the PhD in Physics is 3 years. Admissions are via an entry exam and selected candidates receive a scholarship to cover their living expenses. PhD students attend advanced courses and participate to workshops, conferences and PhD schools. Under the guidance of a personal supervisor, PhD students learn how to carry on research at international level which leads to the writing up of a PhD thesis. The PhD programme is completed successfully after passing a final oral exam.
